

Forester

The position plays a leadership role in the company, and would be responsible for all Capstone's forestry management, acquisition, and recreational land activities.

Job functions will include the following:

- Responsibility for tree planting from inception to free-to-grow status, including all facets of vegetation management
 and materials sourcing. Understanding of stocking standards to achieve sustained harvest yield levels and financial
 objectives.
- Site preparation for planting, including broadcast or prescribed burning, brush piling, soil ripping and herbicide applications. Develop and implement prescriptions to control unwanted competing vegetation.
- Management practices to include pre-commercial thinning, such as releasing overstocked stands by selection thinning at the ten to fifteen year age.
- Evaluate road construction and maintenance activities to assure lowest cost and impact to recreational activities as possible.
- Administration of selective timber harvest operations to include planning, marketing, scheduling, prospectus
 development, negotiating, bidding, selling, contracts, and inspection. Responsible for development of marketing plan
 that maximizes timber revenues, harvest schedule management, timber sale design, preparation and execution, and
 tracking of timber sales.
- Investment and financial analysis of potential acquisitions and an understanding of anticipated rate of return from comprehensive forest products.
- Advance Capstone's recreational land activities, including the conceptualization, development, and marketing of existing and new recreational assets.
- Hunting administration respond to hunting lease customers inquiries, concerns or complaints, assure adequate communication of silviculture activities with hunting lease customers.
